

Update Accounts: As we quickly head into the new year, ensure your account information is up to date so that NCCU can better serve and reach you in 2020

New Requirement For Opening and Updating Accounts: NCCU now requires persons opening accounts, and members updating accounts, to verify income by providing a salary slip/statement for income exceeding \$2500 a month. Self-employed persons must provide documentary record of such income.

Plan Ahead to cover final expenses for yourself and loved ones. Sign up for the Family Indemnity Plan (FIP) or the Bereavement Insurance Plan (FBI). Plans range from \$15.00 to \$158.40 monthly for cash benefits of \$3,500 to \$30,000 each for up to six family members. Get details at your Branch or visit our website.

Be Smart Online: Be careful while shopping online this Christmas.

- Look for secure transaction symbols, such as the little "lock" logo in the lower righthand corner of your browser window and Web addresses starting with "https".
- Log off from a site after you complete a purchase.
 If you can't log off, close your browser to protect your personal information.

Need a Higher Limit on Your Debit Card? Write to us if you need a limit above EC \$2000 for Point of Sale (POS) purchases and online shopping this Christmas.

Traveling for the Holidays? Inform us of your destination(s) if you intend to use your NCCU debit card.

CU ONLINE SERVICES - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

What can I do if I forget my CU Online password or get locked out because of too many unsuccessful attempts to log in?

Go to the CU Online Services login page and click on "Forgot Password" to reset your security answers. https://nccu.onlineaccounts.org/HBNet/App/. If you have forgotten your username, click on "Forgot Username".

What If I get locked out by entering the security code incorrectly?

Please call NCCU Member Services at (767) 255-2126 during regular business hours.

Can I Transfer to another member's account? Yes you can.

- Select "Transfers" from the menu then "Immediate Transfer"
- Select the Share to transfer from. In the "TO" field, select "Any Other Member" from the drop down
- Enter the other Member's information (name, account number, share or loan ID) and the amount.

Account Alerts are Free and are designed to monitor your account and to alert you whenever a transaction or action takes place. Alerts can be customised.

To enroll: Click on the Account Alerts CU Online Services menu option, select Destinations, accept the Terms & Conditions and enter an email address.


